After you have completed the purchase process for your training course you can go back to the homepage of Epilepsy Smart Learning by clicking on the **Home** tab in the top left of the screen.

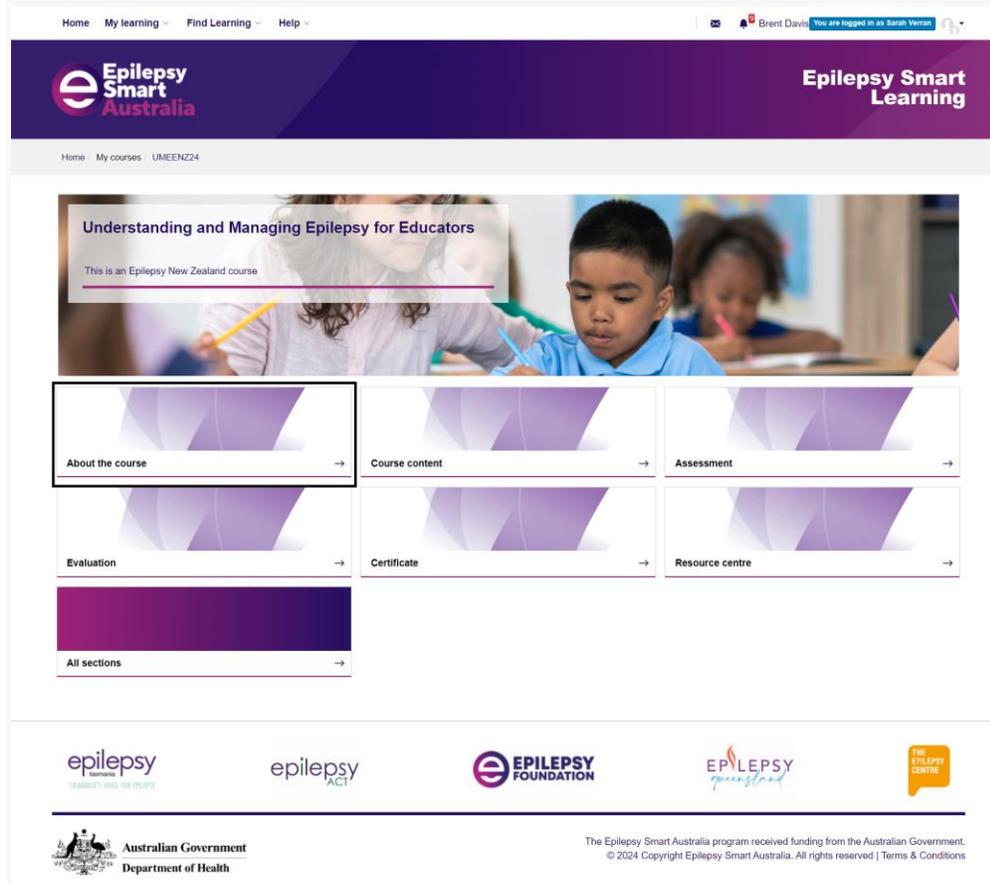
To access your course from the home page, click on the **My Learning** tile.

Navigating your way through the course you are enrolled in is quite simple.

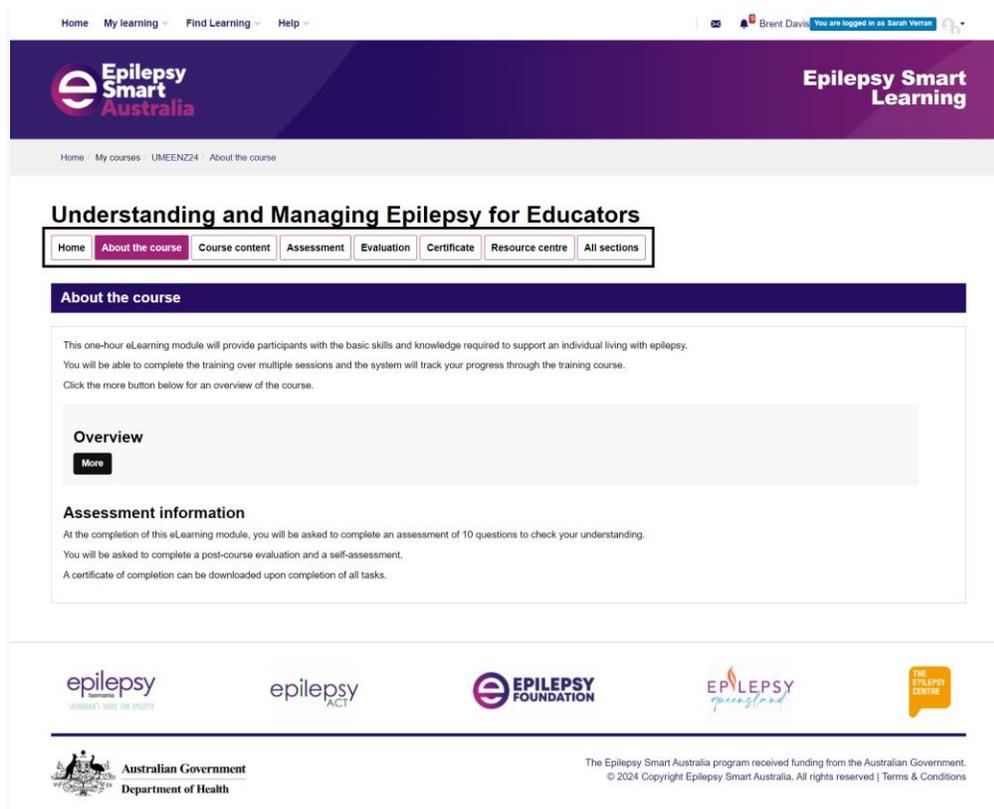
You will see several tiles on your course screen when you first open it and you can enter the course by clicking on the first tile.

I am having trouble logging in, what should I do?

Some of the common problems people may have logging in and potential solutions are outlined below.

1. Make sure you are clicking on the Learners login button and **NOT** the Epilepsy Smart Australia Staff login button
2. When using the "Forgot username or password" link, make sure you are entering your email address into the search field.
3. Only enter your email address into **ONE** of the search fields and **NOT** both.
4. Check your junk mail folder for any emails you may have missed
