At Epilepsy New Zealand it is our mission to improve the lives of those living with epilepsy. We need your help to elevate our fundraising for Purple Day.

#### What is epilepsy?

The brain sends electrical messages to the body. A disruption of electrical activity in the brain can lead to a seizure. This could be a change in the person's movement, behaviour, level of awareness and/or feelings. Epilepsy can be controlled with medication. Epilepsy seizures can vary greatly. Some can cause difficulty in living alone, the ability to drive, ability to work and barriers to independence and social wellbeing.

#### **Charity Art Auction**

- Epilepsy New Zealand invite artists to create and donate an artwork featuring **Resene purple paint** supplied free of charge to the artist.
- A 8x10" canvas will be supplied free of charge to the artist.
- The art auction will run for 2-3 weeks on TradeMe set at \$1 reserve. The auction will close on 26<sup>th</sup>
   March 2025 to mark Purple Day Epilepsy awareness day.
- All proceeds from the TradeMe auction will be donated to Epilepsy New Zealand towards the services
  of epilepsy educators who provide education and support to those living with epilepsy.

#### Artist responsibilities:

- Complete application form, register a place in the auction.
- Create an artwork on supplied 8x10" canvas featuring supplied Resene purple paint.
- Email a photo of finished art work and *title* to Epilepsy New Zealand <u>info@epilepsy.org.nz</u> by 4th March 2025 to be listed on TradeMe for auction.
- On completion of auction, securely wrap the artwork. Write supplied tracking number and address on package for courier pick up.
- It is the artists responsibility to securely wrap the artwork. We recommend a layer of bubble wrap and soft cardboard.

#### **Epilepsy New Zealand responsibilities:**

- Supply canvas and purple paint from Resene to the artist
- Promote the auction on our website, Facebook and newsletter
- Run a charity auction on TradeMe for 3-2 weeks.
- Book courier pick up of art work from artist's address to winning bidder.
- Epilepsy New Zealand reserves the right to decline an artists art work if content is deemed offensive or inappropriate.

- Art works must be completed to photograph for TradeMe by 4th March 2025.
- Once below application is complete, we will confirm your place and registration in the auction.
- In 2025 we will arrange for courier of paint and canvas to your address, pick up of materials from central Hamilton is encouraged.
